



Lyng Parish Council – Cemetery Fees 1st January 2026

Resident refers to a person living in the parish of Lyng. A resident who has moved into a residential or nursing home outside of Lyng, will still be entitled to resident rates, provided reasonable proof can be given that they lived in Lyng prior to the move. Interment fees apply to all burials and ashes interments taking place at the cemetery, whether Exclusive Rights of Burial have been purchased or not. The Parish Council will consider requests from non – residents where there is a link to the village / persons already buried for which the cost of interment (coffin or cremated remains) will be doubled.

Right of burial grant (ERB) – This grant is for a period of 60 years or until the names owner(s) have died, whichever is soonest. When a grave is purchased, this refers to the purchasing of the exclusive right in the grave space and not the purchase of the land itself. All grave owners have a legal right to be buried in the grave and the exclusive right also means that the owner(s) control who can be buried in the plot.

These fees refer to interment in an earthen grave not exceeding 9 feet by 4 feet, with or without exclusive right

Right of burial grant is for a period of **60 years** or until the named owner(s) have died, whichever is soonest.
